Authorizes State Forester to use funds from state forest tree seed bank to establish, maintain and develop seed production areas. Provides specific authority for State Forester and State Board of Forestry to operate state forest tree seed orchard. Creates subaccounts for state forest nursery, state forest tree seed bank and state forest tree seed orchard.
