## **Measure Description:**

Aligns statute relating to the payment of deferred compensation (Oregon Savings Growth Plan) to an alternate payee under judgment or order and to federal tax law. Clarifies that an order creating an Alternate Payee of an Oregon Savings Growth Plan participant may provide that the Alternative Payee may commence payments earlier than the participant would be eligible to commence payments. Clarifies tax reporting requirements for payments to Alternative Payees.
