BACKGROUND: Currently, ORS 807.062(2), states that a resident of Oregon may not operate a motor vehicle in this state unless the person receives a driver license or permit from the Oregon Department of Transportation. Similarly, a mits the offense of failure to register a vehicle if the person owns a vehicle in this state and does not register it with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ORS 803.300).

HB 2034 exempts persons who have been a resident of Oregon for less than 30 days from these requirements.
