WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Adds unremarried surviving spouse of the veteran to persons eligible to receive emergency financial assistance.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Former spouses who have remarried are ineligible
- Whether Emergency Financial Assistance Program is sufficiently funded for the increased number of veterans ٠ returning from the Middle East

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Under the current statute the definition of a veteran's "immediate family" is defined as a spouse, child or stepchild. House Bill 2157 would add "unremarried surviving spouse" to the definition of "immediate family."
