WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Authorizes the State Board of Tax Practitioners to adopt rules pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act. Increases the maximum amount of fees that may be prescribed by board.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: HB 2240 increases the maximum amount of fees that may be charged by the Board of Tax Practitioners for items such as examination applications, license or certificate issuance or renewals, reactivation of inactive licenses, and the restoration of a lapsed license. The measure is tied to a policy package within the Board of Tax Practitioners' proposed budget for the 2007-09 biennium.
