## **REVENUE:** No revenue impact

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows wine or cider from a licensed warehouse to be shipped to a retail licensee if the shipment is made pursuant to sale by a holder of a grower sales privilege license or wholesale malt beverage and wine license.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Measure is a technical correction to ORS 471.242
- Measure only covers wine, not cider or malt beverages •

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** A wine warehouse is allowed to remove wine from their licensed warehouse on behalf of a winery customer in conjunction with that winery's sale to a licensed retailer such as a wine shop or restaurant, but they are not allowed to provide the same services for similar businesses such as a vineyard operator or a business who purchases and resells private label wine under a wholesale malt beverage and wine license.

The measure allows businesses that hold a grower sales privilege license or a wholesale malt beverage and wine license to take advantage of a wine warehouse's full services by allowing these types of license holders to have their wine "directly removed" (delivered) from a licensed warehouse to a wine shop, restaurant, or other retailer.
