BACKGROUND: The Oregon Family Leave Act (OFLA) requires employers of 25 or more employees to provide their workers with job-protected leave to care for themselves or family members in cases of illness, injury, childbirth, or adoption. HB 2635 expands the definition of a "family member" covered under the OFLA to include a grandparent or a grandchild.
