**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Specifies that qualified person who resides in shelter, park, motor home, marina or other identifiable location may register to vote. Provides that person may use office of county clerk as mailing address for purposes of registration.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Examples of residents without traditional addresses
- Ability of people residing in homeless shelters to register to vote
- Locations where U.S. mail is delivered to

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Under current law, homeless persons who are otherwise qualified to vote are eligible to register as voters, showing, if necessary, the county clerk's office as their address. HB 2762 clarifies that persons who live in temporary quarters are eligible to register as voters in the same way.
