## **REVENUE:** No revenue impact **FISCAL:** No fiscal impact

**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Extends the authority of disadvantaged, minority, women or emerging small business ability to not obtain a public works bond from one year to four years.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Problems faced disadvantaged, minority, women or emerging small businesses when starting a business.
- The process for obtaining public works bonds.
- Appropriateness of extending the authority to not obtain a public works bond from one year to four or five years.

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Changes authority of effected group's ability not to obtain a public works bond from one year to four years instead of five as proposed in the original bill.

**BACKGROUND:** Under current law contractors or subcontractor must file a bond in the amount of \$30,000 with the Construction Contractors Board before starting work on a contract of subcontract. Also, new businesses owned by minorities, women or an emerging small business has the right to not obtain a public works bond for up to one year.
