**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Requires application for Oregon driver license to include a statement, separately signed by the applicant, stating substantially "I acknowledge that driving while under the influence of intoxicants can result in serious injury or death. I agree that I will not drive while under the influence of intoxicants." Requires signed statement for renewal of Oregon driver license.

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Replaces original bill.

HB 2897A would require those applying for or renewing Oregon driver licenses to sign a separate statement indicating they understand the serious consequences to themselves and others of driving under the influence and agree not to do so.
