WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Permits establishment of a second Oregon Veteran's Home to admit spouses of war veterans. Eliminates the requirement for the second Oregon veteran's Home to obtain a certificate of need from the Department of Human Services. Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

House Bill 3009 would allow for the development of a second Oregon Veteran's Home and remove the requirement to obtain a certificate of need, as required under current statute, from the Department of Human Services.
