WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Recognizes contributions made to communities by persons with developmental disabilities. Recognizes unmet needs of persons with developmental disabilities. Recognizes that the Governor's proposed budget proposes the closure of Eastern Oregon Training Center and that closure would have a significant impact on the City of Pendleton. Recommends using savings in Governor's proposed budget to provide services for persons with developmental disabilities and specifically couples any closure of Eastern Oregon Training Center with an economic development plan for the City of Pendleton.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Number of people effected by the closure of the training center
- Focus of the measure being impact of closure on people receiving services from training center

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Eastern Oregon Training Center is an intermediate care facility located in Pendleton, Oregon. The training center is home for up to 50 individuals with developmental disabilities, who reside in eight homes on a small campus which are staffed seven days a week, 24 hours per day. In addition to direct care staff, each home has a manager and other professional staff including nurses, physicians, psychologists, occupational and physical therapists, dentists and hygienists, psychiatrists and vocational and recreational service personnel.
