WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows the Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries to accept a writ or a summons served on behalf of an unregistered farmworker camp operator.

ISSUES DISCUSSED: Provisions of the measure.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Current law authorizes the Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) to accept a service of process, that is, a writ or a summons, on behalf of unregistered farm labor contractors. SB 204 authorizes the Commissioner to accept a service of process for unregistered farmworker camp operators.
