WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Eliminates authority of State Board of Psychologist Examiners to deny license renewal for a licensee's failure to complete required pain management education program prior to paying license renewal fee.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

• Similar issue experienced by other health licensing boards; most have already resolved the problem

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Oregon Laws 2005 Chapter 162- authorizes the Pain Management Commission of the Department of Human Services Pain Management Division to require that all health professionals take pain management education as part of their continuing education. A technicality in the way the measure was written allowed the Oregon Board of Psychologist Examiners to deny the renewal of a license or initial licensure of an applicant until the pain management course was completed. The board asserts that this was not the intent of the previous legislation.
