## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: A recent violation of pesticide use in eastern Oregon raised concern that the current civil penalty does not provide an adequate deterrent in instances where there is gross negligence or willful misconduct related to the use of pesticides.
