BACKGROUND: The National Guard is found in both the United States Constitution and the Oregon Constitution. The Oregon National Guard has a long tradition and history dating back to 1843. The tradition and history of the Oregon National Guard was grounded on the basis of its mission statement; "*A ready force equipped and trained to respond to any contingency. When we are needed, we are there.*" The Oregon Military Department's purpose is to administer, house, equip and train the Oregon National Guard, a ready force to support the Governor during unrest or natural disaster and as a reserve force to the United States Air Force and the United States Army.
