

House Bill 2006

Sponsored by Representative BARNHART

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Gives preference in state contracts for procurement of aggregate, sand, gravel or rocks obtained from land that is not in floodplain or composed of soils in Class I to IV.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state contracts for certain minerals.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 279A.140 to**
5 **279A.155.**

6 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding provisions of law requiring a state contracting agency to**
7 **award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder or best proposer or provider of a quotation,**
8 **a state contracting agency wishing to procure aggregate, sand, gravel or rocks shall give**
9 **preference to the procurement of aggregate, sand, gravel or rocks obtained from land that**
10 **is not in a floodplain or composed of soils in Class I to IV.**

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NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
