Gives preference in state contracts for procurement of aggregate, sand, gravel or rocks obtained from land that is not in floodplain or composed of soils in Class I to IV.

4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 279A.140 to
5	279A.155.
6	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding provisions of law requiring a state contracting agency to
7	award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder or best proposer or provider of a quotation
8	a state contracting agency wishing to procure aggregate, sand, gravel or rocks shall give
9	preference to the procurement of aggregate, sand, gravel or rocks obtained from land that
10	is not in a floodplain or composed of soils in Class I to IV.
