HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2084

On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "and". 1 2 In line 4, delete "254.056,". In line 5, after "316.102" insert "; and declaring an emergency". 3 Delete lines 7 through 26 and insert: 4 5 "SECTION 1. Sections 1a to 3 of this 2007 Act are added to and made a part of ORS 6 chapter 254. "SECTION 1a. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 254.056, for the calendar year 2008, a presidential 7 primary election shall be held in this state on the first Tuesday in February. At the election 8 9 held on the first Tuesday in February, electors may vote for candidates for nomination for 10 President of the United States and for any other candidates or measures listed on the ballot under subsection (2) of this section. 11 "(2) Notwithstanding ORS 171.185, 203.085, 221.230, 255.345 and 258.075, for the calendar 1213 year 2008, an election that would otherwise be held on the second Tuesday in March shall 14 be held on the first Tuesday in February. The ballot at the election shall include the names 15of candidates for the party nomination for President of the United States who qualified for 16 the ballot under ORS 249.078, the names of candidates to be nominated or elected to other 17 offices at the election and the number, ballot title and financial estimates of any measures. 18 "(3) The Secretary of State may adopt rules governing the procedures for conducting an 19 election under this section. 20 "(4) This section is repealed January 1, 2009. 21"SECTION 2. The Secretary of State may participate and represent this state in dis-22cussions among the states or with any unit of the federal government in setting a schedule 23 of rotating regional presidential primary elections. 24 "SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided, as used in ORS chapters 246 to 260: 25"(1) 'Primary election' means the primary election held on the third Tuesday in May of each even-numbered year as described in ORS 254.056. 26 27"(2) 'Presidential primary election' means an election: 28 "(a) Held in each year in which electors of the President and Vice President of the United 29States are to be elected; "(b) At which electors may vote for candidates for nomination for President of the United 30 31 States: and 32"(c) Held on a date that is different from the date of the primary election.". 33 On page 16, after line 23, insert: "SECTION 38. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 34 35peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect

1 on its passage.".
