SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Exempts Secretary of State from requirement to submit summaries of contracts entered into with other public bodies to Oregon Department of Administrative Services.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to summaries of agreements of state agencies; creating new provisions; and amending ORS
190.115 and 190.118.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 190.115 is amended to read:

6 190.115. (1) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section, a state agency that enters 7 into an agreement under ORS 190.110, 190.420 or 190.485 on or after August 16, 1999, or an agree-

8 ment under ORS 190.112 or under ORS 660.342 shall submit a summary of the agreement to the

9 Oregon Department of Administrative Services within the 30-day period immediately following the

10 effective date of the agreement.

11 (2) The summary required by this section must include the following information:

12 (a) Names of the parties to the agreement.

13 (b) Date of the agreement.

14 (c) Subject matter of the agreement.

15 (d) The agency through which a person may obtain a copy of the agreement.

16 (3) A state agency that is required to submit a summary of an agreement to the department 17 under this section shall submit the summary through electronic means.

(4) The Secretary of State shall prepare and maintain the summary described in sub sections (1) and (2) of this section. However, the secretary is not required to submit the
summary to the department.

21 SECTION 2. ORS 190.118 is amended to read:

22 190.118. (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall keep an index of summaries 23 of agreements into which state agencies enter under ORS 190.110, 190.112, 190.420, 190.485 or 24 660.342. The department shall include in the index the information provided by state agencies under 25 ORS 190.115.

26 (2) The department shall require state agencies, except the Secretary of State, to update in-27 formation in the index through a secure website that is protected with a password.

(3) The department shall make the information in the index accessible to the public through a
searchable public website on the Internet.

30 <u>SECTION 3.</u> The amendments to ORS 190.115 and 190.118 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2007 31 Act apply only to agreements entered into on or after the effective date of this 2007 Act.
