SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Adds unremarried surviving spouse of veteran to persons eligible to receive emergency financial assistance.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to emergency financial assistance; amending ORS 408.500.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 408.500 is amended to read:

5 408.500. (1) The Oregon Veterans' Emergency Financial Assistance Program is created.

6 (2) The purpose of the program is to provide emergency financial assistance to Oregon veterans

7 and their immediate families for needs that include but are not limited to:

8 (a) Emergency or temporary housing and related housing expenses, such as expenses for utili-

9 ties, insurance, house repairs, rent assistance or food;

10 (b) Emergency medical or dental expenses;

11 (c) Emergency transportation;

12 (d) Expenses related to starting a business, such as business licenses or occupational licenses;

13 (e) Temporary income after military discharge; and

14 (f) Legal assistance.

(3) The [Director] Department of Veterans' Affairs shall administer the program created under subsection (1) of this section and shall adopt rules implementing [subsection (2) of this section] the program, including but not limited to establishing procedures for applying for emergency financial assistance and criteria for determining eligibility to receive emergency financial assistance.

20 (4) As used in this section:

21 (a) "Immediate family" means a spouse, unremarried surviving spouse, child or stepchild.

22 (b) "Veteran" means:

23 (A) A veteran as defined in ORS 408.225;

(B) A person who is a member of the Oregon National Guard who has been demobilized after
serving on federal active duty for more than 30 days; or

(C) A person who is an Oregon resident, is a member of the Reserves and has been demobilized
after serving on federal active duty for more than 30 days.
