SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies authority of Office of Degree Authorization to review of proposed publicly funded post-secondary degree programs and degree locations and resolution of disputes relating to degree programs and degree locations.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to higher education degrees; amending ORS 326.075, 348.603 and 351.203.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 348.603 is amended to read:

5 348.603. (1) The Oregon Student Assistance Commission, through the Office of Degree Authori-6 zation, shall:

7 (a) Authorize approved schools to offer academic degree programs;

- 8 (b) Authorize approved degree-granting schools to offer nondegree programs leading to a certif-
- 9 icate or diploma;
- 10 (c) Validate claims of degree possession;
- 11 (d) Terminate substandard or fraudulent degree activities; and
- 12 (e) Review proposed new publicly funded post-secondary **degree** programs and **degree** locations.
- 13 (2)(a) Following review of a proposed new publicly funded post-secondary degree program or

14 degree location, the commission shall recommend resolution to the appropriate governing boards 15 and mediate between the boards to seek a negotiated resolution if:

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(A) There is a detrimental duplication of **degree** programs; or

(B) The degree program or degree location would have a significantly adverse impact on one
 or more other segments of education.

(b) If the boards do not resolve the issue raised under paragraph (a) of this subsection within 90 days of the date when the issue was recommended to the boards for mediation, the commission shall have final authority for approval or disapproval of the **degree** program or **degree** location. If the boards do not resolve the issue, the commission shall approve or disapprove the **degree** program or **degree** location within 180 days of the date when the review began.

(c) If the boards do not resolve the issue, the commission shall approve the **degree** program or
 degree location if the commission finds that the program or location meets an unmet workforce need
 in the state.

(d) The commission shall establish by rule a fair and neutral decision-making process in consultation with representatives designated by the State Board of Education, the State Board of
Higher Education, associations representing Oregon independent colleges, associations representing
Oregon career colleges, and the governing boards of otherwise unrepresented post-secondary

schools. 1

2 (3) The commission, by rule, may impose a fee on any school or person requesting information from the commission. The amount of the fee shall be established to recover designated expenses in-3 curred by the commission in carrying out the administration of ORS 348.594 to 348.615. Any fees 4 collected under this subsection shall be deposited in the Office of Degree Authorization Account 5 established under ORS 348.601. 6

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SECTION 2. ORS 326.075 is amended to read:

326.075. (1) The State Board of Education shall cooperate with the Education and Workforce 8 9 Policy Advisor in the development of a state comprehensive education plan including elementary, secondary and community college education and in review of the board's programs and budget. The 10 board shall submit in timely fashion to the advisor such data as is appropriate in a form prescribed 11 12 by the advisor.

13 (2) The board shall cooperate with the mediation process administered by the Oregon Student Assistance Commission pursuant to ORS 348.603 and, if a negotiated resolution cannot be reached 14 15 by mediation, comply with the decisions of the commission regarding proposed new post-secondary 16 degree programs and proposed new post-secondary degree locations.

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SECTION 3. ORS 351.203 is amended to read:

18 351.203. (1) The State Board of Higher Education shall cooperate with the Education and 19 Workforce Policy Advisor in the development of a state comprehensive education plan including 20post-secondary education and in review of the board's programs and budget. The board shall submit in timely fashion to the advisor such data as is appropriate in a form prescribed by the advisor. 21

22(2) The board shall cooperate with the mediation process administered by the Oregon Student Assistance Commission pursuant to ORS 348.603 and, if a negotiated resolution cannot be reached 23by mediation, comply with the decisions of the commission regarding proposed new post-secondary 24degree programs and proposed new post-secondary degree locations, including those proposed by 25Oregon Health and Science University in cooperation with the board under ORS 353.440. 26

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
