## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Repeals provision allowing health insurance policies to exclude coverage for loss due to insured's use of intoxicants or controlled substances.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to health insurance policies; creating new provisions; and repealing ORS 743.480. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. ORS 743.480 is repealed. 4

SECTION 2. The repeal of ORS 743.480 by section 1 of this 2007 Act does not apply to a 5

policy, contract, subscriber agreement, rider or indorsement delivered or issued for delivery 6 7 in this state by an insurer before the effective date of this 2007 Act. However, the repeal of

ORS 743.480 by section 1 of this 2007 Act applies to a new, and to a renewal or extension of 8

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an existing, policy, contract, subscriber agreement, rider or indorsement delivered or issued

for delivery in this state by an insurer on or after the effective date of this 2007 Act. 10

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
