## House Bill 2481

Sponsored by Representatives MACPHERSON, RICHARDSON

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies basis for establishing schedule of payments to lottery contractors by Oregon State Lottery Commission. Requires commission to study feasibility of implementing competitive bidding process for awarding video lottery game retailer contracts.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 461.445 is amended to read:

6 461.445. In establishing its schedule of payments to contractors, the Oregon State Lottery Com-

7 mission shall undertake to develop a system that maximizes the net revenue to the state for the

8 public [purpose consistent with providing a reasonable rate of return for contractors] purposes de-

9 scribed in section 4, Article XV of the Oregon Constitution.

SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon State Lottery Commission shall conduct a study to determine 10 the feasibility of implementing a competitive bidding process for awarding contracts to video 11 lottery game retailers, as defined in ORS 461.217, for video lottery game terminals operated 12 under authority of the commission. The study shall focus on maintaining the current 13structure and operational methods employed by the commission for video lottery games 14 while replacing the current method of determining the percentage of net receipts paid to 15 video lottery game retailers with a competitive bidding process among qualified applicants 16 17seeking video lottery game retailer contracts.

(2) The commission shall report the results of the study to the Governor and to the
Seventy-fourth Legislative Assembly in the manner specified in ORS 192.245 by June 30, 2008.
