SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Requires use of electronic signaling device by individual or group engaging in mountain climbing above timberline during five-month period.]

Requires individual or group climbing above 10,000 feet on Mount Hood during five-month period to carry two-way, electronic communication device and electronic locator device.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the use of electronic signaling devices; amending ORS 401.625.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 401.625 is amended to read:

5 401.625. (1) An individual, or at least one individual in a group, who engages in mountain

6 climbing in the month of November, December, January, February or March on Mount Hood

7 at an elevation above 10,000 feet shall carry a two-way, electronic communication device and:

8 (a) A global positioning system receiver;

9 (b) A personal locator beacon transmitter;

10 (c) A Mount Hood mountain locator unit; or

11 (d) Other comparable device.

12 (2) A person who guides for compensation an organized group that includes children under 18

years of age on any mountain at a point above the timberline [must] shall carry an altimeter, a
contour map of the area and a compass.
