## House Bill 2534

Sponsored by Representative BUTLER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows county community corrections agency to reject, based on offender's noncompliance or outstanding warrants, application for transfer of offender's supervision to county.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 423.500 to
5	423.560.
6	SECTION 2. (1) A county community corrections agency may reject an application for
7	transfer of an offender's supervision to the county because the offender:
8	(a) Has failed to comply with conditions of release; or
9	(b) Is subject to an outstanding warrant.
10	(2) The Department of Corrections shall establish by rule guidelines for the transfer of

11 supervision of offenders from one county to another.
