House Bill 2551

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires that Oregon Liquor Control Commission offer consolidated application for persons seeking issuance or renewal of limited or full on-premises sales licenses and applying for video lottery game contracts. Provides that consolidated application includes information required for application to Oregon State Lottery Commission to enter into contract as video lottery game retailer. Requires approval of Oregon State Lottery Commission for form of application.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 471.

5 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall offer a consolidated appli-6 cation for persons seeking issuance or renewal of limited or full on-premises sales licenses 7 and seeking to enter into video lottery game contracts. The consolidated application must 8 include all information identified by the Oregon State Lottery Commission under subsection 9 (3) of this section for the purposes of applying to the Oregon State Lottery Commission to 10 enter into a contract with the Oregon State Lottery Commission as a video lottery game 11 retailer under ORS 461.217.

(2) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall accept a consolidated application offered
 under this section only if the applicant pays all fees identified by the Oregon State Lottery
 Commission under subsection (3) of this section.

(3) The Oregon State Lottery Commission shall inform the Oregon Liquor Control Commission of all information and fees required by the Oregon State Lottery Commission from
a person applying to enter into a contract with the Oregon State Lottery Commission as a
video lottery game retailer under ORS 461.217.

(4) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission may offer a consolidated application under
 this section only after the form of the application is approved by the Oregon State Lottery
 Commission.

(5) To the extent possible, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall formulate the consolidated application to ensure that an applicant need not provide the same information twice, even though the information is required by both the Oregon Liquor Control Commission and the Oregon State Lottery Commission.

(6) As soon as practicable after receiving a consolidated application under this section,
 the Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall forward a copy of the application to the Oregon
 State Lottery Commission along with the fees identified by the Oregon State Lottery Commission shall
 mission under subsection (3) of this section. The Oregon State Lottery Commission shall
 thereafter process the application in the same manner as applications made directly to the

1 Oregon State Lottery Commission.
