House Bill 2576

Sponsored by Representative GARRARD, Senator WHITSETT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs school districts that share territory to change boundaries or merge so that districts no longer share territory. Specifies exception. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to school districts; and declaring an emergency. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. (1) Any school district that shares territory with another school district 4 shall either change the boundaries of the school district or merge with the other district so $\mathbf{5}$ that the districts no longer share territory. Any boundary change or merger required under 6

7 this section must be effective prior to July 1, 2008.

(2) This section does not apply to school districts with territory in a county with a pop-8 ulation of 10,000 or less. 9

10 SECTION 2. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect 11

on its passage. 12
