"SECTION 26c. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) to (4) of this section: 2021"(a) A public official may not appoint, employ or promote a relative or member of the 22household to, or discharge, fire or demote a relative or member of the household from, a 23position with the public body that the public official serves or over which the public official exercises jurisdiction or control, unless the public official complies with the conflict of in-24 25terest requirements of this chapter. (b) A public official may not participate as a public official in any interview, discussion 2627or debate regarding the appointment, employment or promotion of a relative or member of the household to, or the discharge, firing or demotion of a relative or member of the 28 29 household from, a position with the public body that the public official serves or over which the public official exercises jurisdiction or control. As used in this paragraph, 'participate' 30 does not include serving as a reference, providing a recommendation or performing other 31ministerial acts that are part of the normal job functions of the public official. 3233 "(2) A member of the Legislative Assembly may appoint, employ, promote, discharge, fire or demote, or advocate for the appointment, employment, promotion, discharge, firing or 34demotion of, a relative or member of the household to or from a position on the personal 35 legislative staff of the member of the Legislative Assembly. 36 37 "(3)(a) A public official may appoint, employ, promote, discharge, fire or demote, or ad-38 vocate for the appointment, employment, promotion, discharge, firing or demotion of, a relative or member of the household to or from a position as an unpaid volunteer with the 39 40 public body that the public official serves or over which the public official exercises juris-41 diction or control. 42"(b) Paragraph (a) of this subsection does not apply to the appointment, employment,

promotion, discharge, firing or demotion of a relative or member of the household to a position as an unpaid member of a governing body of the public body that the public official
serves or over which the public official exercises jurisdiction or control.

1 "(c) A relative or member of the household described in paragraph (a) of this subsection 2 may receive reimbursement of expenses provided in the ordinary course of business to sim-3 ilarly situated unpaid volunteers.

4 "(4) This section does not prohibit a public body from appointing, employing, promoting, 5 discharging, firing or demoting a person who is a relative or member of the household of a 6 public official serving the public body.

⁷ "<u>SECTION 26d.</u> (1) Notwithstanding ORS 659A.309 and except as provided in subsections
(2) to (4) of this section, a public official acting in an official capacity may not directly supervise a person who is a relative or member of the household.

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"(2) A member of the Legislative Assembly may directly supervise a person who:

"(a) Is a relative or member of the household; and

"(b) Serves as a public official in a position on the personal legislative staff of the mem ber of the Legislative Assembly.

"(3)(a) A public official acting in an official capacity may directly supervise a person who
 is a relative or member of the household if the person serves as an unpaid volunteer.

16 "(b) Paragraph (a) of this subsection does not apply to service by a person in a position 17 as an unpaid member of a governing body that a public official of whom the person is a rel-18 ative or member of the household serves or over which the public official exercises jurisdic-19 tion or control.

"(c) A relative or member of the household serving as an unpaid volunteer described in paragraph (a) of this subsection may receive reimbursement of expenses provided in the ordinary course of business to similarly situated unpaid volunteers.

"(4) A public body may adopt policies specifying when a public official acting in an official
 capacity may directly supervise a person who is a relative or member of the household.".
