HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2606

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 22 and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 1. ORS 329.451 is amended to read: "329.451. (1) In order to receive a high school diploma from a school district, a student must 3 meet the requirements established by the State Board of Education and the school district and, 4 $\mathbf{5}$ while in grades 9 through 12, must complete: "(a) At least 24 [credit hours] credits, as defined by rule of the board; 6 "(b) Three [years] credits of mathematics; and 7 "(c) Four [years] credits of English. 8 9 "(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, a school district may award a diploma to a student who does not [meet] satisfy the requirements of subsection (1)(b) or (c) of this section if the 10 student: 11 12"(a) Has met or exceeded the academic content standards for mathematics or English established 13 by the board; or 14 "(b) Displays proficiency in mathematics or English at a level established by the board. 15"(3) A student may satisfy the requirements of subsection (1) of this section in less than 16 four years. If a student satisfies the requirements of subsection (1) of this section and a 17 school district has the consent of the student's parent or guardian, the school district shall 18 award a diploma to the student upon request from the student. 19 "(4) If a school district has the consent of a student's parent or guardian, the school 20 district may advance the student to the next grade level if the student has satisfied the re-21quirements for the student's current grade level. (5) The requirement for obtaining the consent of a student's parent or guardian under 22subsections (3) and (4) of this section does not apply to a student who is: 2324 "(a) Emancipated pursuant to ORS 419B.550 to 419B.558; or 25"(b) 18 years of age or older.". 26
