House Bill 2611

Permits owner of any qualified residential property to apply for second 15-year term of historic property special assessment.

SECTION 1. ORS 358.541 is amended to read: 5

6 358.541. [(1)] Residential property may [not] qualify for a second term of classification and spe-

cial assessment as historic property under this section unless[:] the historic property is disquali-7 8 fied under ORS 358.515.

9 [(a) If the property is located within a city, the governing body of the city has adopted a resolution

or ordinance authorizing a second term of historic property classification and special assessment for 10 residential property; or] 11

12 [(b) If the property is located within unincorporated territory of a county, the governing body of the

13county has adopted a resolution or ordinance authorizing a second term of historic property classi-

fication and special assessment for residential property.] 14

[(2) The city or county authorizing a second term of historic property classification and special 15assessment for residential property shall send a copy of the authorizing resolution or ordinance to the 16

State Historic Preservation Officer.] 17

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
