## House Bill 2717

Sponsored by Representative BUTLER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Board of Medical Examiners to issue provisional license to practice medicine to certain applicants. Establishes criteria for provisional licensure. Limits physician holding provisional license to practice of medicine in counties with fewer than 50,000 residents. Sunsets January 2, 2014.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to provisional license to practice medicine.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 677. 4

 $\mathbf{5}$ SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, a physician who

6 holds a full, unrestricted license to practice medicine in any other state or territory of the

7 United States or the District of Columbia, has not been the recipient of a professional sanc-

8 tion in any other state or territory of the United States or the District of Columbia and has

9 applied to the Board of Medical Examiners for the State of Oregon for a license to practice

10 medicine in this state under ORS 677.120 shall be issued a provisional license to practice

11 medicine in this state if the applicant has:

13 (b) Paid the required application fee determined by the board pursuant to ORS 677.265; 14 and

(c) Provided to the board documentation that the applicant holds an active license to 15practice medicine from the agency regulating the practice of medicine in the jurisdiction in 16 17 which the applicant is licensed and that the applicant has not been the recipient of a pro-18 fessional sanction in that jurisdiction.

- (2) A provisional license issued under this section: 19

20 (a) Is valid until the board either approves or denies the application for licensure made 21by the applicant under ORS 677.120; and

22(b) Shall be issued by the board within 10 working days of the date the applicant meets 23 the requirements of subsection (1) of this section.

24 (3) A physician holding a provisional license issued under this section is subject to all the 25provisions of this chapter and to all the rules of the board and has the same duties and re-26 sponsibilities and is subject to the same penalties and sanctions as any other person licensed 27under this chapter.

28(4) A provisional license to practice medicine issued under this section is valid only in 29 counties in this state with a population of fewer than 50,000 residents.

30 SECTION 3. This 2007 Act is repealed on January 2, 2014.
