22	On page 8, delete lines 1 through 13 and insert:
23	" <u>SECTION 5.</u> ORS 163.185 is amended to read:
24	"163.185. (1) A person commits the crime of assault in the first degree if the person:
25	"(a) Intentionally causes serious physical injury to another by means of a deadly or dangerous
26	weapon; [or]
27	"(b) Intentionally or knowingly causes serious physical injury to a child under six years of
28	age[.]; or
29	"(c) Intentionally, knowingly, recklessly or with criminal negligence causes serious
30	physical injury to another while operating a motor vehicle under the influence of intoxicants
31	in violation of ORS 813.010 and:
32	"(A) The person has at least three previous convictions for driving while under the in-
33	fluence of intoxicants under ORS 813.010, or its statutory counterpart in any jurisdiction, in
34	the 10 years prior to the date of the current offense; or
35	"(B)(i) The person has a previous conviction for any of the crimes described in subsection

"(2) The previous convictions to which subsection (1)(c)(B) of this section apply are: 4 "(a) Manslaughter in the first degree under ORS 163.118; $\mathbf{5}$ "(b) Manslaughter in the second degree under ORS 163.125; 6 "(c) Criminally negligent homicide under ORS 163.145; 7 "(d) Assault in the first degree under this section; 8 "(e) Assault in the second degree under ORS 163.175; or 9 "(f) Assault in the third degree under this section. 10 "[(2)] (3) Assault in the first degree is a Class A felony.". 11 12
