Limits number of medium and high risk offenders that may be supervised by parole and probation officers who engage in case supervision.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to parole and probation officers.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "parole and probation officer" has the meaning

5 given that term in ORS 181.610.

6 (2) A parole and probation officer who is engaged in case supervision may not supervise

more than 60 medium and high risk adults on parole, probation or post-prison supervision
per month, averaged over a 12-month period.
