House Bill 2786

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that violation of certain skiing prohibitions and requirements is Class A violation, punishable by maximum fine of \$720.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to skiing; amending ORS 30.985 and 30.990.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 30.985 is amended to read:

5 30.985. (1) Skiers shall have duties [*which*] **that** include but are not limited to the following:

6 (a) Skiers who ski in any area not designated for skiing within the permit area assume the in-7 herent risks thereof.

- 8 (b) Skiers shall be the sole judges of the limits of their skills and their ability to meet and 9 overcome the inherent risks of skiing [and shall maintain reasonable control of speed and course].
- 10 [(c) Skiers shall abide by the directions and instructions of the ski area operator.]
- 11 (c) A skier who is injured shall, if reasonably possible, give notice of the injury to the ski

12 area operator before leaving the ski area.

(d) Skiers shall familiarize themselves with posted information on location and degree of diffi culty of trails and slopes to the extent reasonably possible before skiing on any slope or trail.

15 (2) The following prohibitions and requirements apply to skiers:

(a) Skiers shall abide by the directions and instructions of the ski area operator.

- 17 (b) Skiers shall maintain reasonable control of speed and course.
- [(e)] (c) Skiers [shall] may not cross the uphill track of any surface lift except at points clearly
 designated by the ski area operator.
- 20 [(f)] (d) Skiers [shall] may not overtake any other skier except in such a manner as to avoid 21 contact and shall grant the right of way to the overtaken skier.

[(g)] (e) Skiers shall yield to other skiers when entering a trail or starting downhill.

23 [(h)] (f) Skiers [must] shall wear retention straps or other devices to prevent runaway skis.

- [(*i*)] (g) Skiers [*shall*] may not board rope tows, wire rope tows, j-bars, t-bars, ski lifts or other similar devices unless they have sufficient ability to use the devices, and skiers shall follow any written or verbal instructions that are given regarding the devices.
- [(j)] (h) Skiers, when involved in a skiing accident, [*shall*] may not depart from the ski area without leaving their names and addresses if reasonably possible.
- 29 [(k) A skier who is injured should, if reasonably possible, give notice of the injury to the ski area 30 operator before leaving the ski area.]
- 31 [(L)] (i) Skiers [shall] may not embark or disembark from a ski lift except at designated areas

1 or by the authority of the ski area operator.

2 [(2)] (3) Violation of any of [the duties of skiers set forth in] provisions of subsection [(1)] (2)

3 of this section entitles the ski area operator to withdraw the violator's privilege of skiing.

4 (4) Violation of subsection (2) of this section is a Class A violation.

5 **SECTION 2.** ORS 30.990 is amended to read:

6 30.990. Ski area operators shall give notice to skiers of [their] the duties, prohibitions and

7 requirements that apply to skiers under ORS 30.985 in a manner reasonably calculated to inform

8 skiers of those duties, prohibitions and requirements.
