SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Provides that use of state provided Internet access by members and staff of Legislative Assembly is considered to be use on state business for purposes of Legislative Assembly.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to use of public facilities; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 171.113.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 171.113 is amended to read:

5 171.113. It is the policy of the Legislative Assembly that all use of state provided [phones]

6 telephones or Internet access by members of the Legislative Assembly or by legislative staff at

7 the members' direction, including [phones] telephones assigned or Internet access provided either

8 at the member's residence or at the State Capitol building, [shall be] is considered to be [used] use

9 on state business for purposes of the Legislative Assembly.

10 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 171.113 by section 1 of this 2007 Act apply to use 11 of Internet access that occurs on or after the effective date of this 2007 Act.
