Delete lines 6 through 20 of the printed bill and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 2. (1) A person under 18 years of age commits the offense of operating a mo-3 tor vehicle while using a mobile communication device if the person, while operating a motor vehicle on a highway, uses a mobile communication device and the person holds: 4 $\mathbf{5}$ "(a) A provisional driver license issued under ORS 807.065; 6 "(b) A special student driver permit issued under ORS 807.230; or 7 "(c) An instruction driver permit issued under ORS 807.280. "(2) For purposes of this section, 'mobile communication device' means a text messaging 8 9 device or a wireless, two-way communication device designed to receive and transmit voice 10 or text communication. "(3) This section does not apply to a person summoning medical or other emergency help 11 if no other person in the vehicle is capable of summoning help. 12"(4) Notwithstanding ORS 810.410, a police officer may enforce this provision only as a 13 secondary action when a driver of a motor vehicle has been detained for a suspected traffic 14 15violation or some other offense. 16 (5) The offense described in this section, operating a motor vehicle while using a mobile 17 communication device, is a Class B traffic violation.".
