On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 6 through 16 and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 2. (1) A health benefit plan, as defined in ORS 743.730, may not deny benefits 3 to an individual who is covered under the plan because that individual has a pervasive developmental disorder. 4 5 "(2) The coverage for treatment of a pervasive developmental disorder may be subject to 6 the same requirements in the plan that apply to physical illness generally, including 7 copayments, coinsurance or deductibles. "(3) As used in this section, 'pervasive developmental disorder' means a neurological 8 9 condition that includes Asperger's syndrome, autism, developmental delay, developmental 10 disability or mental retardation. "(4) The provisions of ORS 743.700 do not apply to this section. 11 "SECTION 2a. The Health Resources Commission shall: 1213 "(1) Conduct a review of available medical and behavioral health evidence on the treatment of pervasive developmental disorders. 14 "(2) In conducting its review, work with the Public Employees' Benefit Board, the Health 1516 Services Commission, the Department of Human Services and the Department of Education. 17 "(3) Report its findings and recommendations to the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly in the manner provided in ORS 192.245.". 18
