## House Bill 2944

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS AND LABOR

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires Commissioner of Bureau of Labor and Industries, upon request, to determine whether project is public works on which payment of prevailing wage rates is required.

Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 279C.800 to 4 279C.870. 5 6 SECTION 2. (1) The Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries shall, upon the request of a public agency, contractor or worker, make a determination about whether a 7 8 project or proposed project is or would be a public works on which payment of the prevailing rate of wage is or would be required under ORS 279C.840. 9 (2) The requester shall provide the commissioner with information necessary to enable 10 the commissioner to make the determination. 11 12 (3) The commissioner shall make the determination within 15 days after receiving the 13request or 15 days after the requester has provided the commissioner with the information necessary to enable the commissioner to make the determination, whichever is later. 14 (4) The requester or any person adversely affected or aggrieved by the commissioner's 15determination may institute a proceeding for judicial review of the determination in accord-16 ance with ORS 183.484. 17 (5) The commissioner shall adopt rules establishing the process for requesting and mak-18
