House Bill 3109

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Human Services to furnish certified copy of birth certificate without charge to applicant for state medical assistance.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to birth certificates; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 432.146. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2007 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 432.005 to 4 432.165. 5 6 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding ORS 432.090 and 432.146, the State Registrar of the Center for Health Statistics shall furnish to a person a certified copy of a birth certificate without 7 8 a charge for the copy or for the processing of the copy when the birth certificate is requested 9 by the person for the purpose of applying for medical assistance as defined in ORS 414.025. SECTION 3. ORS 432.146 is amended to read: 10 432.146. Except as provided in ORS 432.090 and 432.312 and section 2 of this 2007 Act, subject 11 12 to the review of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, the Department of Human Ser-13vices shall establish all fees for services or records provided under ORS 432.005 to 432.165. The fees and charges established under this section shall be authorized by the Legislative Assembly for the 14 department's budget, as the budget may be modified by the Emergency Board. 15SECTION 4. Section 2 of this 2007 Act applies to requests for birth certificates made on 16 or after the effective date of this 2007 Act. 17
