## House Bill 3113

Sponsored by Representatives FLORES, MAURER; Representatives BOQUIST, WHISNANT

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Amends duties of Department of Human Services to include investigations of allegations of child abuse at child care facilities.

<b>2</b>	Relating to child abuse investigations; amending ORS 657A.400.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 657A.400 is amended to read:
5	657A.400. (1) An authorized representative of the Department of Human Services may inspect
6	the premises of a child care facility certified under ORS 657A.280 to determine:
7	(a) Whether the facility is in conformity with applicable laws and regulations relating to health
8	and sanitation[.]; and
9	(b) Upon receipt of an oral or written complaint of child abuse at a child care facility,
10	whether the complaint is substantiated.
11	(2) An authorized representative of the Department of Human Services shall inspect any child
12	care facility when requested to do so by the Child Care Division in accordance with arrangements
13	under ORS 657A.420 and shall submit written findings to the Child Care Division. The Child Care
14	Division shall not issue or renew any certification for any child care facility for which an inspection
15	by the Department of Human Services has been requested unless an authorized representative of the
16	Department of Human Services submits a written finding that the facility is in compliance with ap-
17	plicable laws and regulations relating to health, [and] sanitation and child safety.
18	(3) An environmental health specialist's inspection may be performed by a private consultant so
19	long as the consultant is registered under ORS chapter 700.
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
