House Bill 3148

Prohibits public school teachers from striking.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to teachers; amending ORS 243.736.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 243.736 is amended to read:

5 243.736. (1) It [shall be] is unlawful for [any emergency telephone worker, parole and probation

6 officer who supervises adult offenders, police officer, firefighter or guard at a correctional institution

7 or mental hospital] the following public employees to strike or recognize a picket line of a labor

8 organization while in the performance of official duties:

9 (a) Emergency telephone worker;

10 (b) Firefighter;

- 11 (c) Guard at a correctional institution or mental hospital;
- 12 (d) Parole and probation officer who supervises adult offenders;

13 (e) Police officer; or

14 (f) Teacher employed by a school district.

(2) As used in this section, "emergency telephone worker" means a person whose official focal
duties are receiving information through a 9-1-1 emergency reporting system under ORS 401.710 to
401.816, relaying such information to public or private safety agencies or dispatching emergency
equipment or personnel in response to such information.
