SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows members of Oregon National Guard to enroll in specified classes at state institution of higher education or community college at no cost.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1 Relating to education benefits for members of Oregon National Guard; and declaring an emergency.

2 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

3 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

4 (a) **"Limited enrollment class" means a class in which enrollment is limited to a specified**
5 **number of students.**

6 (b) **"Member of the Oregon National Guard" means a person who is:**

7 (A) **An active or retired member of the Oregon National Guard; and**

8 (B) **A resident of Oregon.**

9 (2) **If a state institution of higher education or a community college offers a limited en-**
10 **rollment class and the specified number of students have not enrolled in the class by the**
11 **enrollment deadline, the remaining unfilled spaces in the class shall be offered at no cost to**
12 **members of the Oregon National Guard.**

13 (3) **A member of the Oregon National Guard may enroll in the limited enrollment class**
14 **upon proof of membership in the Oregon National Guard.**

15 (4) **A member of the Oregon National Guard may enroll in one or more limited enroll-**
16 **ment classes even if the member is not enrolled at the state institution of higher education**
17 **or the community college as a full-time or part-time student.**

18 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2007 Act first applies to the 2007-2008 school year.**

19 **SECTION 3. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
20 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
21 **July 1, 2007.**
