SUMMARY

Requires Department of Corrections to take all reasonable steps to have criminal alien transported to birth country to serve remaining sentence.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to alien criminals.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Upon the request of the family of an alien in the physical and legal cus-5 tody of the Department of Corrections, the department shall contact the Attorney General

6 of the United States and take all reasonable steps to ensure that the alien is returned to the

7 alien's birth country to serve the remainder of the alien's sentence if:

8 (a) The alien is convicted of a crime other than murder or aggravated murder; and

9 (b) The victim of the crime for which the alien is convicted does not object.

10 (2) As used in this section, "alien" means a person who is a citizen or national of a for-11 eign country.

(3) The department may adopt rules necessary to carry out the provisions of this 2007
Act.
