

House Bill 3413

Sponsored by Representatives THATCHER, HUNT; Representatives BOQUIST, ESQUIVEL, FLORES, NELSON, SCHAUFLER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates funds to Department of Transportation for projects of statewide significance.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2007.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to financial administration of the Department of Transportation; appropriating money; and
3 declaring an emergency.

4 Whereas the Legislative Assembly recognizes that an efficient transportation system is critical
5 to the economy of the State of Oregon and its residents, vital for the movement of people and goods,
6 and necessary for the safety of Oregon residents; and

7 Whereas the Department of Transportation has identified, and the Legislative Assembly has re-
8 cognized, a number of major transportation projects in its list of May 2002 that are projects of
9 statewide significance; and

10 Whereas current funding is not adequate to provide for the development and completion of these
11 projects of statewide significance; now, therefore,

12 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

13 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
14 **ated to the Department of Transportation, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2007, out of the**
15 **General Fund, the amount of \$50,000,000, which shall be expended for projects of statewide**
16 **significance that are on the list adopted by the Oregon Transportation Commission in May**
17 **2002.**

18 **SECTION 2. This 2007 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
19 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect**
20 **July 1, 2007.**
