SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Prohibits Department of State Lands from requiring lessee to allow public access to or across property used for growing agricultural crops.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Department of State Lands property.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "agricultural crops" means plants of a type and 5 variety commonly used in whole or in part as food for humans.

6 (2) The Department of State Lands may not require a person that leases property from

the department for the planting, cultivation or harvesting of agricultural crops to allow
public access to or across that property.

9 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2007 Act applies to public access on or after the effective

10 date of this 2007 Act, regardless of whether the lease of the property is entered into before,

11 on or after the effective date of this 2007 Act.
