House Bill 3502

SUMMARY

Modifies reimbursement amounts received by rural hospitals adjacent to one or more urban areas.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to rural health; amending ORS 414.728.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 414.728 is amended to read:

414.728. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, for services provided to 5 6 persons who are entitled to receive medical assistance and whose medical assistance benefits are 7 not administered by a prepaid managed care health services organization, as defined in ORS 414.736, the Department of Human Services shall reimburse Type A and Type B hospitals and rural critical 8 access hospitals, as described in ORS 442.470 and identified by the Office of Rural Health as rural 9 hospitals, fully for the cost of covered services based on the most recent audited Medicare cost re-10 port for Oregon hospitals adjusted to reflect the Medicaid mix of services. 11 12 (2) A rural hospital classified as either a Type A or a Type B hospital, or a rural critical

access hospital, that is located in a rural county adjacent to one or more urban areas shall
be considered to be located in the urban area to which the greater number of workers in the
county commute.

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
