SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Prohibits sale or rental of ultra-violent video games to children. Provides exception if child has permission of parent or guardian.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to ultra-violent video games.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "ultra-violent video game" means a video game

depicting serious injury to human beings in a manner that is especially heinous, atrocious
 or cruel.

7 (2) A person may not sell or rent an ultra-violent video game to a child under the age

of 18 unless the child has the permission of the child's parent or guardian to purchase or
rent the game.
