Allows dogs accompanied by their owners into restaurants and bars.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to dogs.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 **<u>SECTION 1.</u>** (1) As used in this section:

5 (a) "Bar" means an establishment that has a full or limited on-premises sales license is-

6 sued by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission under ORS chapter 471.

7 (b) "Restaurant" has the meaning given that term in ORS 624.010.

8 (2) A restaurant or bar may allow a dog, accompanied by its owner, into the restaurant

9 or bar provided that the dog, at all times while in the restaurant or bar:

- 10 (a) Remains on a leash;
- 11 (b) Remains with its owner; and

12 (c) Is well behaved.

13 (3) A restaurant or bar that allows a dog, accompanied by its owner, into the restaurant

14 or bar may restrict the dog and its owner to a dog friendly area within the restaurant or bar.

- 15 (4) This section does not apply to a dog guide as defined in ORS 346.610 or other assist-
- 16 ance animal as defined in ORS 346.680.
