## House Bill 3547

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides ballot title for House Joint Resolution 56 (2007). Declares emergency, effective on passage.

9	AMENDS CONSTITUTION: ALLOWS STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT TO USE ITS

11	RESULT OF "YES" VOTE: "Yes" vote limits Oregon Constitution's free expression provision

15 16	RESULT OF "NO" VOTE: "No" vote retains current state constitutional law, which prohibits
17	governments from imposing restrictions on nude or partially nude performances based on

20	SUMMARY: Amends Oregon Constitution. Currently, free expression provision of Oregon
21	Constitution prohibits government restrictions on nude and partially nude performances
22	based on expressive nature of activity. The free expression provision of the United States
23	Constitution allows some restrictions on nude and partially nude performances. The measure
24	allows the state or a local government to use its regulatory authority to restrict any strip
25	act to the extent allowed under the United States Constitution. The measure defines "strip
26	act" as a performance in which a person or persons appear or become nude or partially nude
27	before patrons of a club or business, customers of the person or person, or members of the
28	public. The measure allows the state or a local government to establish a more detailed de-
29	finition. The measure requires good faith and common sense interpretation and implemen-
30	tation, and indicates that measure is intended to allow restrictions for strip acts as many
31	other state and local governments have done, to the extent allowed under the United States

8	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2007 Act takes effect
9	on its passage.
